## FORUM 82 EXHIBIT RULES

### Exhibit / Exhibit Space

For the purpose of this agreement, the term “exhibit” or “exhibit space” refers to both an in-person exhibit space and virtual exhibit space if not specifically defined.

### Venue

Forum 82 is scheduled as an in-person event to be held at the Palm Beach County Convention Center, May 5-7, 2026, in West Palm Beach, Florida. Forum 82 will transition to a virtual event or possibly a hybrid event to include both in-person and virtual participants if pandemic restrictions prevent the Vertical Flight Society from producing the event at its traditional size and capacity. Exhibitors will be notified no less than 60 days before the event if the originally planned in-person format must be transitioned to a virtual or hybrid event.

### Exhibitor Eligibility

Products and services displayed at Forum 82 must be associated with the vertical flight, aviation or aerospace technology industries. VFS reserves the right to reject an exhibit application or remove an exhibitor's display if a company's product/service does not meet this requirement.

### Exhibit Space Package

Exhibit space for an in-person event is sold in 10'x10' units. Linear booths will be separated by standard pipe and drape and will be provided a standard booth ID sign. Forum 82 exhibitors will be provided one (1) full conference registration for each 10'x10' exhibit space purchased but will not exceed a total of five (5) conference registrations. Forum 82 exhibitors will be provided two (2) exhibit hall registrations for each 10'x10' exhibit space purchased but will not exceed ten (10) exhibit hall registrations. Forum 82 exhibitors participating in an in-person event may submit an exhibitor description to the Vertical Flight Society for publishing in the *Forum 82 Final Program*.

Should Forum 82 be transitioned to a virtual event due to pandemic restrictions, an exhibitor's in-person exhibit package will automatically default to the applicable virtual booth space package based on an exhibitor's originally contracted exhibit space size. The transition to a virtual event will not change or affect an exhibitor's previously contracted price or payment.

### Subleasing or Sharing Exhibit Space

Exhibitor may not sublet or share exhibit space, nor display, advertise articles not manufactured or sold by the exhibiting company, except where such articles are necessary for proper demonstration or operation of the exhibitor's display.

## FORUM 82 EXHIBIT RULES Continued...

### Use of Exhibit Space

All exhibitor activities must be confined to the limits of an exhibitor's allocated exhibit space and must not interfere with the activity of other exhibitors. All exhibits shall serve the interest of VFS members and Forum 82 attendees and shall be operated in a professional and dignified manner at all times. In-person exhibits must comply with all exhibit hall set up and dismantling rules as stated in the *Forum 82 Exhibitor Service Kit*.

Should it become necessary to transition Forum 82 to a virtual event, an exhibitor shall design a virtual booth by following the guidelines and templates provided by the Vertical Flight Society and the virtual event platform. Exhibitors will be listed in an alphabetical order on the virtual exhibit platform. It is possible an exhibitor's corporate logo may appear near a competitor's logo.

### Exhibitor Giveaways, Lotteries and Contests

Exhibitors conducting a contest or drawing of any kind must follow all governmental laws, ordinances, rules and regulations. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to make sure they correctly follow all rules and regulations. Any violations will be at the sole expense and fault of the exhibitor. VFS is not responsible or liable for any contests, drawings or giveaways held prior, during or after the meeting.

### VFS and Forum 82 Logo

The VFS and Forum 82 logo is property of the Vertical Flight Society and may not be used without receiving approval from the Vertical Flight Society. An exhibitor shall not in any manner indicate that VFS approves or endorses its products or services without written consent from VFS.

### Licenses and Permits

Exhibitor shall be responsible for obtaining any licenses, permits or approvals required under local or state law applicable to exhibit space. An exhibitor shall be responsible for paying all associated taxes, license fees or other charges that shall become due to any government authority in connection with their exhibit.

### Liability Insurance

The exhibitor acknowledges that neither the VFS nor any of the Indemnities maintain insurance covering exhibitors' property, nor is VFS responsible for obtaining insurance covering such property and any loss or damage incurred by an exhibitor. Upon signing the Application for Exhibit Space and Contract, the exhibiting firm is asked to provide the VFS with a certificate of insurance or an affidavit that carries a minimum of \$1,000,000.00 in general liability insurance applicable to its exhibitor participation at the VFS 82<sup>th</sup> Annual Forum and Technology Display by April 10, 2026. ### No-Show Policy

An exhibiting company will be considered a no-show if its exhibit space is not prepared in time for the opening of the event. If such a situation occurs, an exhibitor shall be deemed to have withdrawn from the event and will forfeit its exhibit space payment.

### Hold Harmless – Indemnification

Exhibitor acknowledges that VFS is not liable for any and all claims, demands or damages of any kind arising from its exhibit display at Forum 82. Exhibitor acknowledges that VFS is not liable for any and all claims, demands or damages of any kind arising from the use of a virtual event platform or third-party website. VFS is not responsible or liable for internet delays or outages associated with the production of a virtual event.

### Force Majeure

It is mutually agreed that if Forum 82 is cancelled in whole or in part, or its scheduled opening is cancelled or delayed, due to fire, explosion, strike, freight embargo, act of God, act of public enemy, act of war, war, act of terrorism, civil disturbance, act of any government, de jure or de facto, or other government declaration or regulation, epidemic or other event over which VFS has no control, then the exhibitor contract may be immediately amended by VFS, and an exhibitor hereby waives any and all claims against the VFS for damages, reimbursement, refund, or compensation. VFS shall not be financially liable in the event the show is interrupted, cancelled, moved or rescheduled.

### Agreement and Amendments to Exhibit Rules

All matters and questions covered or not covered in the Forum 82 Exhibit Rules are subject to the decision of the Vertical Flight Society. Exhibit rules and regulations may be amended or changed at any time by the Vertical Flight Society and all amendments and changes will be binding on all parties. Any violation of the Forum 82 Exhibit Rules shall constitute a breach of this contract. Remedy to any breach includes, but is not limited to, termination of any and all rights to the exhibit space and the forfeiture of any fees paid.
